Dear Mr. Barofsky:

The anticipated use of the TARP funds was to augment capital of the bank to allow for expanded lending to better serve our community. The TARP funds for our bank were all put into Tier 1 Capital of the bank and are segregated as Perpetual Preferred Stock. No TARP funds remain unspent. Our lending has increased in the short time since receiving the TARP funds by 5.63% from \$9,433,516 to \$9,964,730. I have by attachment included a general ledger comparison for February 4, 2009 and March 4, 2009 reflecting these figures.

Executive compensation has not changed from what it was before receiving TARP funds to what it is now. No changes are anticipated that would violate the Department of Treasury guidelines. We have no longer-term nor deferred forms of executive compensation.

We anticipate leveraging the TARP funds used to increase Tier 1 capital to further increase the lending in our community ongoing into the future.
