### TAX INFORMATION FOR U.S. TAXPAYERS LIVING ABROAD

The IRS has developed Publication 4732, *Federal Tax Information for U.S. Taxpayers Living Abroad*, as a resource to assist taxpayers in locating useful tax information to aid in the preparation of their returns and/or in resolving tax account problems. The Publication provides a snapshot of tax resources and contacts for U.S. taxpayers (citizens, resident aliens or others) living abroad.
