2.1 eDoc and Postage Statement Functionality

2.1.1 Mail.dat Job Submissions

January 8, 2012

- Mail.dat supported versions are Mail.dat 11-2 and Mail.dat 12-1
- USPS will allow Mail.dat 11-1 submissions after January 8, 2012 for new mailings a mailing date that is before January 22, 2012 and to update previously submitted mailings.
- Mail.dat 11-2 supports limited products and prices for a mailing date on or after January 22, 2012.
- Mail.dat 12-1 does not support mailing dates before January 22, 2012.

April 1, 2012

- Mail.dat supported versions are Mail.dat 11-2 and Mail.dat 12-1
- Support for Mail.dat 11-1 updates will end on April 1, 2012. USPS allowed Mail.dat 11-1 submissions after January 8, 2012 for new mailings with mailing dates before January 22, 2012 and to update previously submitted 11-1 mailings. Last date for this support is March 31, 2012, starting April 1, 2012 support ends for Mail.dat 11-1.
- USPS will continue to support Mail.dat 11-2.
- USPS will continue to support Mail.dat 12-1.

June 10, 2012

- Mail.dat supported versions are Mail.dat 12-1 and Mail.dat 12-2
- USPS will allow Mail.dat 11-2 submissions after June 10, 2012 for new mailings with a mailing date before June 24, 2012 and to update previously submitted 11-2 mailings post June 24, 2012.
- Mail.dat 12-1 supports limited enhancements for mailing date on or after June 24, 2012.
- Mail.dat 12-2 does not support a mailing date before June 24, 2012.

- Mail.XML v10.0C supports limited products and prices for mailing date on or after January 22, 2012.
- Mail.XML v11.0D does not support mailing date before January 22, 1012.

April 1, 2012

- Mail.XML supported versions are Mail.XML v10.0C and v11.0D
- USPS will continue to support Mail.XML v10.0C.
- USPS will continue to support Mail.XML v11.0D.

June 10, 2012

Mail.XML supported versions are Mail.XML v11.0D and v12.0A

- USPS will allow Mail.XML v10.0C submissions after June 10, 2012 for new mailings with mailing date before June 24, 2012 and to update v10.0C mailings after June 24, 2012.

- Mail.XML v12.0A does not support mailing date before June 24, 2012.

2.2 Data Distribution Functionality

January 8, 2012

- Effective April 1, 2012, the USPS will no longer support Mail.XML v6.0D for FAST functionality. Support for FAST Mail.XML v6.0D will end on March 31, 2012.

June 10, 2012

- Mail.XML supported versions are FAST Mail.XML v8.0B, v10.0, and v12.0A
- FAST Mail.XML v12.0A scheduled to be deployed.

October 14, 2012

- Mail.XML supported versions are FAST Mail.XML v8.0B, v10.0, v12.0A, and v12.0B**
- After the FAST 24.0 release (April 2013), the USPS will no longer support Mail.XML v8.0B for FAST functionality.
