Red Ribbon Week, October 22-26

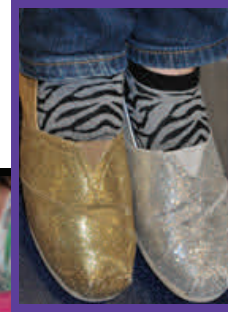

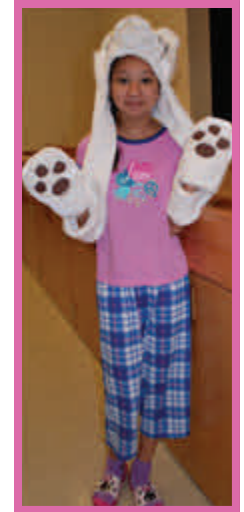

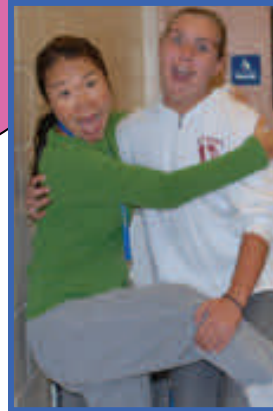
