## News from the School Nurse

New Students: Letters to parents regarding immunization records will be sent and doctor's letter for student's medication (i.e. inhaler) and allergies. Please check with your child to see if he/she received a letter from me.

11 year vaccinations: T-dap and Meningococcal conjugate vaccinations are required for students 11 years old and above. If your child receives these vaccinations, please provide copy to school nurse's office. You will also receive reminder from me after your child turns 11.

Medication policy: Students are not allowed to carry or bring any medication at school without doctor's letter. This applies to ALL medications including eye drops, over the counter medications, and topical medicated creams.

Students who have a body temperature above 100 F will be sent home after contacting a parent. For throwing up and having diarrhea, the school nurse will determine case by case whether a student needs to go home and discuss this with parents.

Please keep in mind that she is the school nurse for both Osan American HS and Osan MS and works at OAHS on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.

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

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### Update Contact Information and DERO Documentation
