## California Wildfires Situation Report # 11 October 29, 2007 (1:00 PM EDT)

## **Highlights:**

- As of 11:12am EDT October 29, the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) has reported 23 total wildfires that have burned over 517,000 acres in Southern California since October 20.<sup>1</sup>
- As of 10:00am EDT (October 29), San Diego Gas and Electric (SDG&E) reports 4,839 customers are without power in California due to the fires and earlier high winds. This represents less than 1 percent of the total customers in California.<sup>2</sup> As of 11:00am EDT (October 29), Southern California Edison (SCE) confirmed that all power has been restored to those customers reported earlier.<sup>3</sup>
- The California Independent System Operator Corporation (CA-ISO) reported that the San Onofre nuclear generating unit restarted on October 26 and as of 10:00am EDT (October 29) is now at full load. CA-ISO also reports no problems with the bulk power systems in Southern California and does not anticipate any impacts to grid operations this week from the active fires.
- SDG&E estimates that 97 percent of fire-impacted customers will be restored by November 4 and 100 percent restoration by November 11. - SDG&E reported that as of 11:30am EDT (October 28), there were 150 customers without natural gas service, down from 678 customers reported on October 26.

## **ESF 12 Actions:**

• ESF-12 personnel staffing the FEMA National Response Coordination Center (NRCC) were demobilized last evening October 28. ESF-12 personnel continue to staff the FEMA Region IX Joint Field Office (JFO) in Pasadena, CA.
