NASA ANNOUNCES NEW SHARED SERVICES DEPUTY DIRECTOR

In 2005, Ms. Dubuisson joined the newly forming NSSC as Deputy Director, Business and Administration. She became Director of this office in 2007. Ms. Dubuisson was appointed to the federal Senior Executive Service (SES) in September 2007. A graduate of the Florida Institute of Technology, Orlando, Florida, with an M.B.A., Ms. Dubuisson also holds a bachelor's degree in business administration from Delta State University, in Cleveland, Mississippi.
