 - Lead service designee for 24 critical EUCOM functions

PREVENT

- Reinforce commitment to NATO Article 5, ensure interoperability, sustain relationships and access
- Trained and Ready Forward-Stationed Forces

 - 12th Combat Aviation Brigade (Ansbach)
 - Army Theater Enabling Commands

- Title 10 Support: Including US Army NATO, US Army Africa and Army personnel assigned across the region

SHAPE

- Keep European partners as producers of security rather than consumers
- Reininvigorate US land forces role in NATO
- Training and Partner Engagement with regional partners and Allies at the Joint Multinational Training Command(JMTC) and throughout the Theater
- Innovative use of rotational and forward deployed capabilities to Develop Partner Capacity
- Contribute to US strategic flexibility by exercising regional access
- Conducting 17 Annual Combined Exercises with 36 Countries
- Stabilizing Presence – Set the Theater
- Support regional discourse in the Mediterranean and Levant

WIN

- Initial staging base; access into less stable global regions
- Rapid crisis response capabilities for an uncertain future
- Theater opening capabilities
