For example:

- Designate a "safehaven" in your home. A place all family members know to go to when an emergency strikes.
- Have a two week supply of non-perishable food and drinking water in your safehaven.
- Scan to a thumb drive of all your important family documents (passports/visas, marriage and birth certificates, insurance documents, etc.). Keep originals in a fire-safe box.

DRY SEASON = WATER CONSERVATION

Dry season is a tough time of year on the local environment and we should all do our part to conserve water.

Here are some useful tips:

- REDUCE—Don't leave the water running while brushing your teeth and challenge yourself to take a shorter shower, even flush less often!
- REUSE—After washing dishes use that same water on outdoor plants. For house plants, use water collected from your dehumidifier or condensation from your air conditioner.
- Let your grass grow a little longer than normal between cutting and use less water on landscaping in general.
- Wash clothes on full load for maximum efficiency.

CAMEROONIAN VISA EXPIRING SOON?

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO DO TO GET IT RENEWED.

If Tourist Visa Expires While in Cameroon

When your visa expires, you'll need to contact the Frontier Police to ask for an extension. It's important to provide a letter stating your case and deliver it to





c/o The Frontier Police

The Delegate General for National Security

Yaoundé, Cameroon

- The letter or petition will require a duty stamp. This can be purchased at the Sous-Prefecture (opposite the Governor's office). A stamp costs CFA 1,000. Be prepared for further fees in case a visa extension is granted.
- If the extension is granted, it will be issued for 7 days up to the maximum of 30 days ONLY; this extension requires an additional duty stamp costing 50,000 CFAF.
- A tourist may get 1 extension only.
- Only the Frontier Police can decide whether to extend the visa or to issue a "Carte de Séjour" (Resident Permit).
- It is very difficult for a tourist to get visa extension of more than 30 days or a "Carte de Séjour" (Resident Permit).


