Attacks spur warnings

Police and school officials are warning parents to alert and children not to walk alone after two 12-year-old girls were assaulted near their schools in the Riverside area — likely by different men — within days.

A girl walking to her middle school in Rubidoux north of Riverside on Thursday morning was approached by a man who tried to pull her into a truck. She managed to escape, unlike a girl who was abducted and raped Tuesday evening in the La Sierra neighborhood, police said.

Authorities said they have evidence to believe the two incidents involved the same man.

He was driving a late-1980s four-door sedan that is faded red or burgundy with gray seats.

Most of the La Sierra area is in Alvert United School District, but the Riverside district has schools nearby as well.
