1. Purpose. To approve disestablishment of subject shore activity detachments per reference (a).
2. Background. This is an administrative organization correction action. The detachments concerned were slated for disestablishment under a 2004 Navy Public Affairs Reorganization and were, in fact, effectively disestablished in 2006 with the removal of all personnel. This notice officially disestablishes the detachments, removes them from the Standard Navy Distribution List and directs Defense Finance and Accounting Service to remove the Unit Identification Codes (UICs) from the active UIC database.
3. Organizational Changes. Disestablish subject shore activity detachments effective immediately. The following applies:

#### 4. Action

a. Commander, Naval Installations Command will take appropriate action to disestablish subject shore command detachments.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will delete the PLA in the Central Directory Component effective immediately unless otherwise directed via official correspondence. Correspondence concerning the PLA should be forwarded to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (NAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), Bldg. 1265, Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek Fort Story, Virginia Beach, VA 23459-5000 or by calling (757) 322-1149/1150. NAVNETWARCOM will coordinate removal of the PLA in the Defense Messaging Service system with applicable Navy Computer and Telecommunications Area Master Station.

c. Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33), will revise reference (b).

5. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
