Subj: DISESTABLISHMENT OF NAVAL FACILITIES EXPEDITIONARY LOGISTICS CENTER AND NAVAL FACILITIES ENGINEERING SERVICE CENTER, AND CONSOLIDATION OF MISSIONS AND FUNCTIONS OF BOTH INTO THE NAVAL FACILITIES ENGINEERING AND EXPEDITIONARY WARFARE CENTER

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A (b) OPNAVNOTE 5400 Ser DNS-33/11U228576 of 1 Oct 2011

1. <u>Purpose</u>. To implement Secretary of the Navy approval of the disestablishment of subject shore activities and establishment of the consolidated activity per reference (a).

2. <u>Background</u>. This action disestablishes two co-located Naval Facilities Engineering Command echelon 3 activities and consolidates their mission and functions into one command to achieve cost savings by eliminating duplicative command functions.

3. <u>Organizational Changes</u>. Disestablish subject shore activities and establish a consolidated activity effective 1 October 2012. The following applies:

## b. Establishment

<u>Mission</u>: To provide specialized facilities engineering, technology, and expeditionary equipment life cycle management; to support delivery and maintenance of quality, sustainable facilities; to acquire and manage capabilities for the Navy's expeditionary combat forces; to provide contingency engineering response; and to enable energy security and environmental stewardship. The NAVFAC Engineering and Expeditionary Warfare Center delivers products and services that are centralized for economy and efficiency, centrally manages and executes assigned programs throughout the enterprise, and provides specialized acquisition expertise to enable NAVFAC's global programs. It supports NAVFAC HQ, NAVFAC Echelon 3 and 4 commands, the NAVFAC Expeditionary Programs Office, the Navy Expeditionary Combat Command, Naval Beach Groups and other Navy expeditionary units ashore, and other supported commands.

## 4. Action

a. Commander, Naval Facilities Engineering Command will take appropriate action to disestablish and establish subject shore commands, and will, consistent with reference (a), issue a

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mission, functions and tasks directive for the new shore activities within 90 days of such establishment. Distribution of said directive will include DNS-33.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will delete and add the PLAs in the Central Directory Component effective 1 October 2012 unless otherwise directed via official correspondence. Correspondence concerning the PLA should be forwarded to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (NAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), Bldg. 1265, Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek Fort Story, Virginia Beach, VA 23459-5000 or by calling (757) 322-1149/1150. NAVNETWARCOM will coordinate removal and addition of the PLAs in the Defense Messaging Service system with applicable Navy Computer and Telecommunications Area Master Station.

c. Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33), will revise reference (b).

5. <u>Cancellation Contingency</u>. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
