Subj: RELOCATE BUREAU OF MEDINE AND SURGERY, WASHINGTON, DC

1. Purpose. To approve relocating subject shore activity and echelon 2 command per reference (a).

2. Background. This relocation is as a result of the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) 2005 direction to the Bureau of Medicine and Surgery (BUMED) to relocate and transfer the current facilities to the Department of State. An extension to the relocation deadline was approved by DoD due to facilities renovations not being completed on time at new location. The Navy Medicine Institute Medical Humanities and Research Leadership will remain at the current location in facilities to be assigned.

3. Organizational Changes. Relocate BUMED effective 1 June 2012. The following applies:

The relocation will have no effect upon existing mission, funding or chain of command for BUMED.


4. Action

a. Chief, BUMED will take appropriate action to relocate subject shore activity.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will revise the PLA in the Central Directory Component effective 1 June 2012 unless otherwise directed via official correspondence. Correspondence concerning the PLA should be forwarded to Naval Network Warfare Command (NAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), Bldg 1265, Joint Expeditionary Base, Virginia Beach, VA 23459-5000 or by calling (757) 322-1149/1150. NAVNETWARCOM will coordinate revision of PLA in the Defense Messaging Service system with applicable Navy Computer and Telecommunications Area Master Station.

c. Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33), will revise reference (b).

5. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
