1. Purpose. To approve relocating subject shore activity and echelon 2 command per reference (a).

2. Background. This relocation is as a result of the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) 2005 direction to the Bureau of Medicine and Surgery (BUMED) to relocate and transfer the current facilities to the Department of State. An extension to the relocation deadline was approved by DoD due to facilities renovations not being completed on time at new location. The Navv Medicine Institute Medical Humanities and Research Leadership will remain at the current location in facilities to be assigned.
