Subj: MODIFICATION OF DIRECTOR, PATROL AND RECONNAISSANCE GROUP PACIFIC; CHANGE IN IMMEDIATE SUPERIOR IN COMMAND (ISIC) FOR COMMANDER, PATROL AND RECONNAISSANCE WING (COMPATRECONWING) TWO AND COMPATRECONWING TEN

1. Purpose. To approve modification of Director, Patrol and Reconnaissance Group Pacific (DIRPATRECONGRUPAC) and change in ISIC for COMPATRECONWING TWO and COMPATRECONWING TEN per reference (a).

2. Cancellation. OPNAVNOTE 5400 Ser DNS-33/12U102035 of 7 Mar 2012.

3. Background. Commander U.S. Fleet Forces Command (COMUSFLTFORCOM) and Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet (COMPACFLT) directed Commander, Naval Air Force, U.S. Pacific Fleet (COMNAVAIRPAC) and Commander, Naval Air Force, Atlantic (COMNAVAIRLANT) to review the Administrative Control (ADCON) of PAC and LANT Maritime Patrol and Reconnaissance (MPR) Forces to ensure general Flag Officer oversight, organizational alignment, and proper assignment of ADCON responsibilities. A fleet review of MPR Forces ADCON resulted in a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between COMNAVAIRPAC and COMNAVAIRLANT to rename Commander Patrol and Reconnaissance Group Atlantic as Commander, Patrol and Reconnaissance Group (COMPATRECONGRU) and Director, Patrol and Reconnaissance Group Pacific as Commander, Patrol and Reconnaissance Group Pacific (COMPATRECONGRUPAC). COMPATRECONGRU will be dual hated as COMPATRECONGRUPAC and both commands will execute a common mission. COMPATRECONGRU will have ADCON of LANT MPR forces and COMPATRECONGRUPAC will have ADCON of PAC MPR forces. This action supports the Fleet Commanders core principles of command and control, organizational standardization, and unity of command.

4. Organizational Changes.

a. Effective immediately, change the name, mission and ISIC for DIRPATRECONGRUPAC. The following applies:

5. Action

a. COMPACFLT / COMNAVAIRPAC will take appropriate action to organize, man, and resource COMPATRECONGRUPAC to exercise Echelon IV ADCON authority, responsibility, and accountability over assigned Pacific MPR forces to include assigned wings, squadrons, combat support units and detachments. Issue a mission, functions, and tasks directive. Distribution of the directive will include Director, Navy Staff (DNS-33).

b. This is advance change 16-12 to reference (b).

c. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will revise the Plain Language Address (PLA) in the Central Directory Component effective immediately unless otherwise directed via official correspondence. Correspondence concerning the PLA should be forwarded to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 2555 Amphibious DR, BLDG 1265, Joint Expeditionary Base, Virginia Beach, VA 23459-5000. Revised command should be activated on Navy Regional Enterprise Message System (NREMS). d. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will revise reference (b).

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for one year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
