- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To modify the missions of various Naval Education and Training Command (NETC) subordinate activities per reference (a).
- 2. <u>Background</u>. This action updates the mission statements of the NETC echelon 3 subordinates to present a standardized and more concise statement. This update results in no change to location, manpower assigned or facilities occupied.
- 3. Organizational Changes. Modify NETC subordinates mission statements effective 1 May 2012. The following applies:
- a. Training Support Center Hampton Roads, Virginia Beach, VA

Revised Mission: To provide centralized student management and training support to NETC activities within the Hampton Roads area of responsibility.

b. Submarine Learning Center, Groton, CT

Revised Mission: To develop and deliver submarine individual and team training to achieve undersea warfare superiority.

c. Center for Service Support, Newport, RI

Revised Mission: To develop and deliver naval administration, logistics and media services training to achieve fleet readiness.

d. Center for Security Forces, Virginia Beach, VA

Revised Mission: To develop and deliver anti-terrorism and Navy security force training to achieve war fighting superiority.

e. Training Support Center, Great Lakes, IL

Revised Mission: To provide centralized student management and training support to NETC activities within the Great Lakes area of responsibility.

f. Center for Naval Aviation Technical Training, Pensacola, FL

Revised Mission: To develop and deliver aviation technical training to achieve Naval aviation war fighting superiority.

g. Center for Explosive Ordnance Disposal and Diving, Panama City, FL

Revised Mission: To develop and deliver explosive ordnance disposal and diver training to achieve war fighting superiority.

h. Training Support Center, San Diego, CA

Revised Mission: To provide centralized student management and training support to NETC activities within the San Diego area of responsibility.

i. Center for Personal and Professional Development, Virginia Beach, VA

Revised Mission: To develop and deliver education and training opportunities that build personal, professional, and leadership competencies to achieve fleet readiness.

j. Center for Surface Combat Systems, Dahlgren, VA

Revised Mission: To develop and deliver surface ship combat systems training to achieve surface warfare superiority.

k. Naval Chaplaincy School and Center, Fort Jackson, SC

Revised Mission: To develop and deliver religious ministry training to achieve fleet readiness.

1. Center for Seabees and Facilities Engineering, Port Hueneme, CA

Revised Mission: To develop and deliver combat skills, construction and facilities engineering training to meet shore based installation requirements and achieve expeditionary warfare superiority.

m. Engineering Duty Officer School, Port Hueneme, CA

Revised Mission: To develop and deliver Naval ships and ship systems life cycle engineering and acquisition training to achieve platform wholeness.

- 4. <u>Action</u>. Commander, Naval Education and Training Command will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to issue a revised mission, functions, and tasks directive for subject commands within 90 days. Distribution of that NETC directive will include Director, Navy Staff (DNS-33).
- 5. <u>Cancellation Contingency</u>. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, which ever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
