- 1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy approval to disestablish subject shore activity per reference (a).
- 2. <u>Background</u>. This action disestablishes Officer in Charge of Construction (OICC) Bethesda as the purpose for which it was established no longer exists. OICC Bethesda was established to serve as the single DoD lead to coordinate facilities engineering/acquisition/maintenance and management of the demolition, renovation, and construction of DoD facilities at the National Naval Medical Center/National Military Medical Center.

- c. Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33), will revise reference (b).
- 5. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
