Subj: CONSOLIDATE, DISESTABLISH, AND RENAME NAVY OPERATIONAL SUPPORT CENTERS POINT MUGU, CA AND PORT HUENEME, CA

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To implement Secretary of the Navy approval to disestablish subject shore activity and CNO approval of the consolidation of functions and renaming of Navy Operational Support Center (NOSC) Port Hueneme per reference (a).
- 2. <u>Background</u>. The actions in this notice are designed to reduce excess Reserve infrastructure by consolidating two NOSCs located in the same vicinity into a single site at NOSC Port Hueneme, and renaming the consolidated NOSC as NOSC Ventura County, located upon Naval Base Ventura County.
- 3. Organizational Changes. Disestablish, consolidate and rename subject commands effective 1 October 2012. The following applies:
