- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To approve the modification of reporting relationship for Navy and Marine Corps Public Health Center per reference (a).
- 2. <u>Background</u>. This action is part of the Surgeon General's initiative to achieve the best organizational structure for Navy Medicine to ensure that sailors and Marines are aligned correctly to best accomplish the mission of providing health care and health care support functions. There are no changes to current manpower, funding or location involved with this modification.
