- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To approve renaming and mission modification of Commander, Patrol and Reconnaissance Group Atlantic (COMPATRECONGRULANT) and change in Immediate Superior in Command for Patrol Squadron Three Zero (VP-30) per reference (a).
