1. <u>Purpose</u>. To approve disestablishment of subject shore activity detachment per reference (a).

- 2. <u>Background</u>. The disestablishment of subject detachment is a result of the determination that the detachment mission at that site could be met by a similar NIOD site at Kaneohe Bay, HI with a plus up of billets. Some billets will also transfer to parent Navy Information Operations Command Georgia at Fort Gordon, GA to meet a need for additional cryptologic support.
- 3. Organizational Changes. Disestablish subject shore activity detachment effective December 31, 2012. The following applies:

NAVNETWARCOM will coordinate removal of the PLA in the Navy Regional Enterprise Message System (NREMS) with applicable Navy Computer and Telecommunications Area Master Station.
- c. Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33), will revise reference (b).
- 5. <u>Cancellation Contingency</u>. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
