RECONNAISSANCE SQUADRON ONE (HUQ-1)

1. <u>Purpose</u>. To approve establishment of subject fleet activity per reference (a).

2. <u>Background</u>. Per Master Aviation Plan (11-02), HUQ-1 is being established to support the Naval Aviation Vertical take-off and landing Tactical Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (VTUAV) requirements. HUQ-1 shore component will serve as the command element and as the first unmanned Fleet Replacement Squadron (FRS) that conducts level 100 training for MQ-8B/MQ-8C VTUAV "Firescout" Air Vehicle Operators (AVO) and Mission Payload Operators (MPO). HUQ-1 sea component will provide unmanned detachments (UDet) that operate from Navy air capable ships to support sea-based Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance (ISR) requirements. The MQ-8B will be primarily based aboard the Littoral Combat Ship (LCS) and integrated into HSM (MH-60R) or HSC (MH-60S) expeditionary squadron detachment operations. The MQ-8C will be assigned to HUQ-1 UDets that primarily operate aboard surface combatants.

## 3. Organizational Changes.

a. Effective 1 October 2012, HUQ-1 is established. The following applies:

Provide Fleet Replacement Squadron (FRS) training for Vertical take-off and landing Tactical Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (VTUAV) operators in support of Littoral Combat Ship (LCS) composite Aviation Detachments from fleet HSM and HSC Expeditionary squadrons; Provide, train, support and deploy unmanned detachments (UDet) to operate VTUAV from navy air capable ships to support Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance (ISR) requirements in support of Conventional Forces or Special Operations Forces (SOF).

### 4. Action

- a. Per reference (a) Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet / Commander, Naval Air Force U.S. Pacific Fleet / Commander, Helicopter Sea Combat Wing Pacific will take appropriate action to establish HUQ-1. Ensure that HUQ-1 shore component is properly manned, fully trained, capably equipped, and well maintained to carry out the FRS production for the MQ-8B/C VTUAV per Master Aviation Plan. Ensure HUQ-1 UDets are deployable, properly manned, fully trained, capably equipped, interoperable, well maintained, and combat-sustainable to meet the sea-based ISR mission requirements. Submit a draft Required Operational Capabilities (ROC) and Projected Operational Environment (POE) instruction for HUQ-1 to OPNAV N2N6/N98 for promulgation as a new directive that will be included as part of the Navy's ROC/POE series of instructions under OPNAV N3N5 management.
  - b. This is advance change 50-12 to reference (b).
