1. Purpose. To approve establishment of subject shore activity detachment per reference (a).

2. Background. The establishment is a result of the decision to transition and upgrade a Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) component site currently at Picatinny to a formal detachment, with a civilian Director in charge. The upgrade now is because all Base Realignment and Closure 2005 directed consolidations of NAVSEA Naval Surface Warfare Center activities dealing with guns and ammunition at Picatinny has been completed. The Navy detachment will be part of an Integrated Weapons and Armaments Specialty Site for guns and ammunition at Picatinny Arsenal, NJ.
