1. Purpose. To approve the modification of Officer in Charge, Patrol and Reconnaissance Force Fifth Fleet Detachment Bahrain (COMPATRECONFORFIFTHFLT DET BAHRAIN) per reference (a).

2. Background. COMPATRECONFORFIFTHFLT DET BAHRAIN (44468) is designated as TASK FORCE FIVE SEVEN (TF-57) per COMFIFTHFLT OPORD 201 and TF-57 is designated as a major O6 command per OPNAVNOTE 5450. This notice modifies COMPATRECONFORFIFTHFLT DET BAHRAIN so as to align the Name, Official in Charge, and revised mission statement with major command status.

4. Action

a.
