



FY 2012 CHIPRA Performance Bonus Awards

December 2012



CMS is awarding nearly \$306 million in CHIPRA Performance Bonuses to 23 states for Fiscal Year (FY) 2012. One additional state – Utah – qualified for a bonus for the first time in 2012. The chart below provides detailed information about the states that will be receiving Performance Bonuses for FY 2012 and highlights the program features in place for each state.

***The enrollment target is based on FY 2007 Medicaid child enrollment and adjusted based on a formula that accounts for population growth and for increases in enrollment during an economic recession. States that exceed their enrollment target have increased enrollment above what would have been expected without expanded outreach efforts. States that exceed their enrollment target by more than 10% qualify for a “Tier 2” performance bonus payment, in which additional enrollment is rewarded at a higher rate.*

Note: This enrollment data and the related bonus amounts are considered preliminary and subject to reconciliation after states’ Medicaid enrollment numbers are finalized in early 2013.
