

ACCESSING DATABASES

Our Library has excellent electronic research databases, such as ProQuest, EBSCOhost, Gale, Praeger Security International, Jane's, JSTOR, CIAO, LexisNexis, Inside Defense, Stratfor, Europa World Plus, and Country Watch. Use KeySearch to unlock results from the Library's online and print collections in a single search.

AKO

Military Journal Articles

AULIMP (Air University Library Index to Military Periodicals) is an online subject index of citations for articles published within English language military and aeronautical journals. http://aulimp.au.af.mil

AULIMP does not provide full text articles, but many of the journals indexed have their own Internet sites where you will find archived articles. Use the "Journals" link from the USAWC Library's web page to search for journal titles in our collection.
