## Military Operations Areas (MOAs)

MOAs frequently used by Kirtland AFB aircraft are depicted in **Yellow**. They are primarily used by F-16s which fly from 500' AGL to FL 500 at speeds over 600 knots performing numerous aggressive maneuvers. The F-16s will be difficult to see even with a good "see and avoid" scan. Make sure you use the radar services of Albuquerque Center when transiting these areas.

## Helicopter LATN

Depicted in **Green** is the helicopter Low Altitude Tactical Navigation (LATN) area. Helicopters primarily operate from 50' to 300' AGL in this area at all hours. Airspeeds range from 80 knots to 160 knots.

## Restricted Areas

Restricted Areas frequently used by Kirtland AFB aircraft are depicted in **Orange**. You are not allowed to transit these areas when they are active, so be sure to remain clear. If in doubt about activity in these areas contact Albuquerque Center.

## MC-130P/H Military Training Routes (MTRs)

The MTRs are depicted in **Red** and extend 5 NM either side of the line. Our C-130s fly the MTRs at altitudes ranging from 100' AGL to 12,000 MSL at speeds of 240 knots around the clock. Be particular vigilant from 100' to 500' AGL or avoid those altitudes completely. Attempt to cross at 90 degree angles and above 1000' AGL.
