- C. (U) RULES OF ENGAGEMENT: CJCS STANDING RULES OF ENGAGEMENT (SROE) ARE IN EFFECT (CJCS 3121.01). INDIVIDUALS WILL NOT, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES, ACCOMPANY U.S. DEA, NAS, OR ALLIED NATION POLICE OR MILITARY FORCES ON ACTUAL COUNTERDRUG FIELD OPERATIONS OR PARTICIPATE IN ANY ACTIVITY IN WHICH HOSTILITIES ARE IMMINENT, AND WILL COMPLY WITH THE LIMITATIONS OF ACTIONS DESCRIBED IN SECDEF 6 OCT 1998 MEMORANDUM; SUBJECT: MILITARY SUPPORT TO COUNTER NARCOTIC ACTIVITY.
- D. (U) THREAT ASSESSMENT: COLOMBIA IS A HIGH THREAT COUNTRY FOR TERRORISM AND CRIME.
- E. (U) FORCE PROTECTION: THE COMMANDER OF DEPLOYING FORCES WILL COORDINATE WITH THE SENIOR MILITARY REPRESENTATIVE ON THE COUNTRY TEAM AND RSO CONCERNING SECURITY AWARENESS, FORCE PROTECTION MEASURES, AND PERSONNEL MOVEMENT LIMITATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF ALL U.S. FORCES. ADDITIONALLY U.S. PERSONNEL WILL DEPLOY WITH THEIR INDIVIDUAL ASSIGNED WEAPONS FOR FORCE PROTECTION MEASURES. WEAPONS WILL BE CARRIED DURING ALL TRAINING SITUATIONS, AND DURING ALL OTHER TIMES AS THE THREAT SITUATION ASSESSMENT WARRANTS. DEPLOYING PERSONNEL ARE NOT AUTHORIZED TO SHIP OR CARRY PRIVATELY OWNED WEAPONS OR AMMUNITION.

(U) STATUS OF FORCE: USCINCSO WILL COORDINATE TO ENSURE THAT PERSONNEL DEPLOYING TO COLOMBIA ARE ATTACHED TO USMILGP-CO TO SECURE STATUS PROTECTION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 5 OF THE 07 OCT 1974 U.S. COLOMBIA AGREEMENT ON ARMY, NAVAL, AND AIR FORCE MISSIONS; USCINCSO WILL COORDINATE WITH USMILGP TO ENSURE APPROPRIATE NOTIFICATION TO AND APPROVAL BY THE GOVERNMENT OF COLOMBIA.
- G. (U) LEGAL REVIEW: THE LEGAL REVIEW WAS CONDUCTED ON 07 SEP 99 (b)(6),(b)(7)(C) AND WAS FOUND LEGALLY SUFFICIENT.
