Synopsis of Subject: (S) SECDEF has invited CJCS to attend a plenary followed by a one-on-one and working lunch with the new UK MOD, The Right Honorable Mr. George Robertson. This will be Mr. Robertson's first visit to the Pentagon as MOD and the first visit to the United States by a UK cabinet minister since the Labour party came to power in the May 1 election. Mr. Robertson is reputedly a supporter of NATO and friendly to the U.S. He has made it a top priority to visit the U.S. early in his tenure to underscore his support for the special relationship. Since many in his party do not share those views, it is particularly important to cultivate good relations with Mr. Robertson and to give him whatever support we can.
