SUMMARY: THIS IIR FORWARDS KOREAN WAR VINTAGE  
PHOTOS OF AMERICAN PRISONERS OF WAR USED TO REBUILD A  
POWERPLANT ON THE NORTH KOREAN/MANCHURIAN BORDER AFTER  
THE KOREAN ARMISTICE WAS SIGNED. ENCLOSURE.

TEXT: 1. SOURCE PROVIDED PRINTS OF AMERICAN  
PRISONERS OF WAR FROM THE KOREAN CONFLICT. THESE POW'S  
WERE REBUILDING A BRIDGE AND POWERPLANT ON THE BORDER OF  
NORTH KOREA AND MANCHURIA, SOMETIME IN 1955 AFTER THE  
ARMISTICE TREATY WAS SIGNED.

2. WHEN ASKED HOW HE ACQUIRED THESE PHOTOS,  
SOURCE FLATLY STATED THAT A "FRIEND"

SOURCE STATED THAT HE HAD  
LEARNED THAT DISCUSSIONS WERE UNDERWAY BETWEEN THE UNITED  
STATES AND RUSSIA CONCERNING POW'S DURING WORLD WAR TWO  
AND KOREA, AND WAS "VERY UPSET AND MAD" THAT THE SOVIETS  
ALLEGED THERE WERE NONE. HE STATED THAT THESE PHOTOS  
WERE PROOF POSITIVE THAT AMERICANS WERE HELD AS PRISONERS  
OF WAR, AND WERE BEING USED FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS  
AFTER THE WAR ENDED.

**Summary**

In early September 1968, while detained in CH'OK-Dong (subward), 16km north of PYONGYANG (YD3822), NKPR, SOURCE heard that a number of Americans were detained in a house in the vicinity of YD38731A. SOURCE learned this information during a casual conversation with a 12 year old boy whom HE met while taking a walk. The boy pointed toward YD38734B and stated that Americans were detained on the other side of #111#23. (No further information.)

### (C) COMMENTS:

SOURCE appeared to be of average intelligence and in good physical condition. HE was cooperative, volunteered information and maintained consistency in HIS statements.

SOURCE completed ten years of education in the NKPR prior to entering the REPUBLIC OF KOREA (ROK) as a refugee in 1950. SOURCE was discharged from the POK Army after three years service.
