SCHOFIELD BARRACKS, Hawaii – Residents in the immediate vicinity of Schofield Barracks may experience an increase in noise as a result of 25th Infantry Division field artillery training exercises, here, scheduled Sept. 18, from 8 a.m.-3 p.m.

Please note, the effects of training vary depending on weather conditions. Overcast conditions may increase noise and vibrations. Smoke may be visible for a short time; however there is no immediate danger.
