### 2013 TEMPORARY JOBS OUTREACH



The White Mountain National Forest (WMNF), an agency within the U.S. Department of Agriculture, is providing notice that it seeks to fill approximately 8–12 temporary positions, if funding is available, during the summer 2013 field season (May thru September). This outreach allows us to identify interested persons. The actual job application announcement and application process will occur thru USAJOBS in February

#### Positions Likely to be Hired:

- **Trail Crew:** Perform maintenance and construction/reconstruction on foot trails and bridges that form part of the 1200 miles of trails on the WMNF.
- **Backcountry Staff:** Performs maintenance of backcountry shelters, cabins, and campsites, and makes visitor contacts promoting Leave-No-Trace principles.
- **Developed Recreation Staff:** Perform maintenance and operational support at developed recreation sites, such as campgrounds and trailheads, across the Forest.
- **Visitor Information Services:** Provide services directly to the visiting public through face to face contact and telephone at one of our four information centers.
- **Timber Stand Improvement Crew:** Performs brush-saw/chainsaw removal of non-commercial trees, collects seedling and tree data, and marking timber for harvest.
- **Construction & Maintenance Crew:** Work as a laborer or equipment operator (CDL required) on road projects across the Forest.
- **Archaeologist:** Conduct field surveys for historical and archaeologist resources in support of ongoing projects.
- **Botanist:** Conduct field surveys for rare plants in support of on going projects.
- **Surveying:** Assist in road, landline and resource surveys.
- **Biological Technician:** Conduct field surveys of wildlife, birds, fisheries and treat invasive plants.

Positions will be stationed out of our administrative sites in Bartlett, Gorham, Conway, and Campton NH.

- Start or update your resume and application in USAJOBS ([www.usajobs.gov](http://www.usajobs.gov)).
- We will make decisions on which positions to hire based on funding in mid-February and will notify you of our decision and the opening of the application process.
- Hiring will be completed by the end of March. Work starts mid-May
