Accelerated Collaborative Physician-Scientist Training

The **NIH MD/PhD Partnership Training Program** offers training, activities and funding for MD/PhD students who conduct their PhD research in the **intramural research program** of the National Institutes of Health.

PROGRAM FEATURES

- ❖ **Collaborative** PhD research projects with premier partner institutions such as **Oxford** and **Cambridge** in the United Kingdom, and the **Karolinska Institutet** in Sweden.
- ❖ **Accelerated training:** mentor selection before enrollment in medical school. PhD thesis research starts immediately after the pre-clinical years of medical school
- ❖ **Tuition and stipend support** for PhD training & eligibility for NIH partnership MSTP funding for medical school at participating institutions
- ❖ Work in the NIH Clinical Research Center, the world's largest clinical facility devoted 100% to research
- ❖ Join a community of more than 100 Students in the NIH Global Doctoral Programs and 400 graduate students at NIH



ELIGIBILITY and APPLICATIONS

- ❖ U.S. citizens or permanent residents with a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university.
- ❖ Apply to the NIH in parallel to AMCAS MD/PhD process. **Deadline in early January. MCAT accepted**
- ❖ Applications also accepted from current medical students
- ❖ We seek those with previous research experience and focused plans for PhD training
