Stellar Brass Technical Rider

Upon Arrival

- -The stage should be available approximately 2-3 hours prior to our scheduled performance. The exact time will be determined prior to our arrival.
- -We require a representative who has complete access to, and is fully knowledgeable of the facility.

Parking Facilities

-Parking spaces are required for 1 midsize car and 1 van.

Stage Requirements

-Minimum stage dimension of 20 feet wide by 15 feet deep are required.

Lighting and Follow Spot Requirements

- -School gymnasium performances do not require special lighting.
- -For auditoriums, concert halls, and hotel convention center ballrooms, Green, White and Red wash are preferred. Lighting should be operated by a qualified lighting technician.
- -The sponsor or hall should provide lighting technicians. They should be in place 15 minutes prior to scheduled sound check.
- -One follow spot with operator is also desired.

Audio

-We require 1 hand held "speaking-voice" microphone on a microphone stand. This should be placed stage front.

Dressing Rooms

-We require 1 dressing room large enough to accommodate 5 men. The room should be furnished with coat racks, mirrors, tables and be in close proximity to restrooms and the stage.

Equipment

- -We require 6 sturdy music stands in good repair, and 5 chairs without arm rests also sturdy and in good repair.
- -The United States flag in a stand and placed stage left is required for performances.

Sound Checks

-The band requires a closed-house sound check prior to every performance
