Hurricane Jeanne Situation Report #8  
September 29, 2004 (4:00 PM EDT)**

**HIGHLIGHTS**

- Currently, nine percent or 798,912 customers in Florida remain without power due to Hurricane Jeanne. Outages from Hurricane Ivan have been reduced to 26,214. See tables below for county outages and restoration schedules.
- FEMA will stand down the Atlanta Regional Operations Center today and move the functions to the DFO in Orlando. OEA continues to staff the ESF-12 desk in Orlando and at the FLEOC in Tallahassee.

**ELECTRIC INFORMATION [Report based on company websites and Florida EOC information 9/29/04 3:15 PM EDT]**

- Florida Power and Light reports that the total number of customers restored now stands at 1,357,100. Currently, 380,300 (9%) remain without power.
- Progress Energy reports 132,725 (9%) customers are without power, down from a peak of 722,000. Progress Energy expects to restore power by midnight Sunday to all customers capable of receiving power.
- Tampa Electric reports 71,200 (11%) customer outages down from a peak of 285,000. Tampa Electric expects to restore 95 percent of the remaining customers by Sunday.
- Outages for Florida municipals are at 141,100, while cooperatives report outages of 73,587 customers.
