Q.D., QD, q.d., qd (for once daily),	Mistaken for each other; the periods or <b>O</b> can be mistaken for an ‘i’	Write ‘ <b>daily</b> ’
Q.O.D., QOD, q.o.d, qod (for once every other day)	Mistaken for each other; the periods or <b>O</b> can be mistaken for an ‘i’	Write ‘ <b>every other day</b> ’
U, u (for unit)	Mistaken for zero, four, or cc	Write ‘ <b>unit</b> ’

It is unacceptable for prescribers to use any of the above abbreviations when writing or typing prescriptions. Ambiguous orders with these abbreviations will require clarification or verification with the prescriber.
