CORI Overview

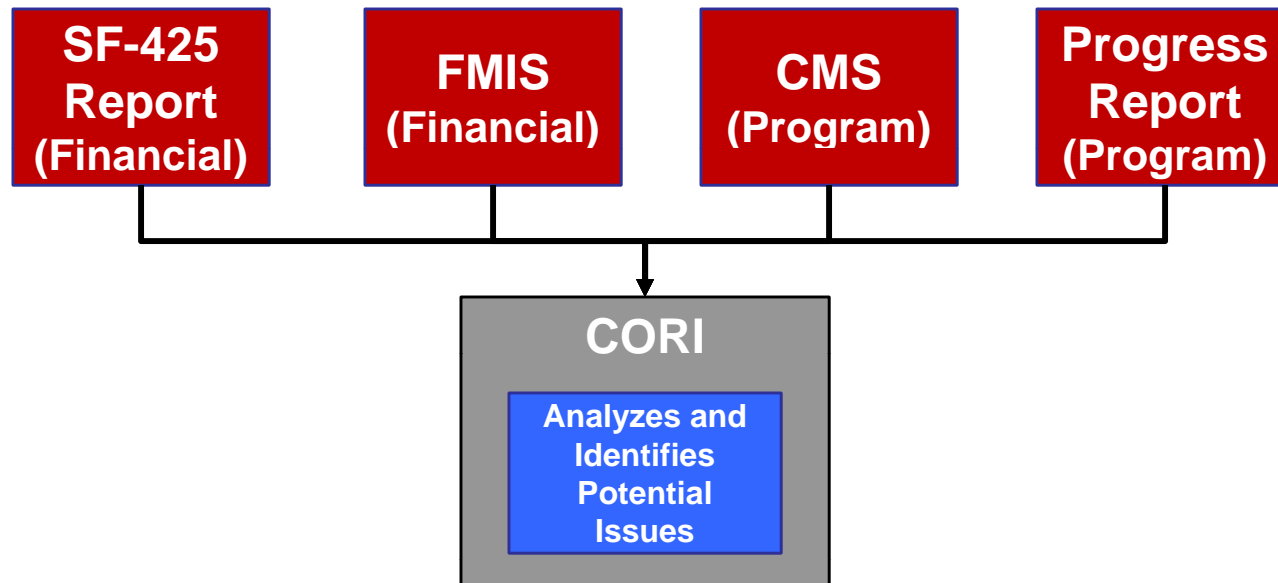
- In 2009, the Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Office was awarded \$1 billion in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding to provide hiring grants to local law enforcement agencies for additional police officers.
- The COPS Office implemented the COPS Outreach and Reporting Integration (CORI) system in response to heightened reporting requirements regarding ARRA funding.

CORI Overview

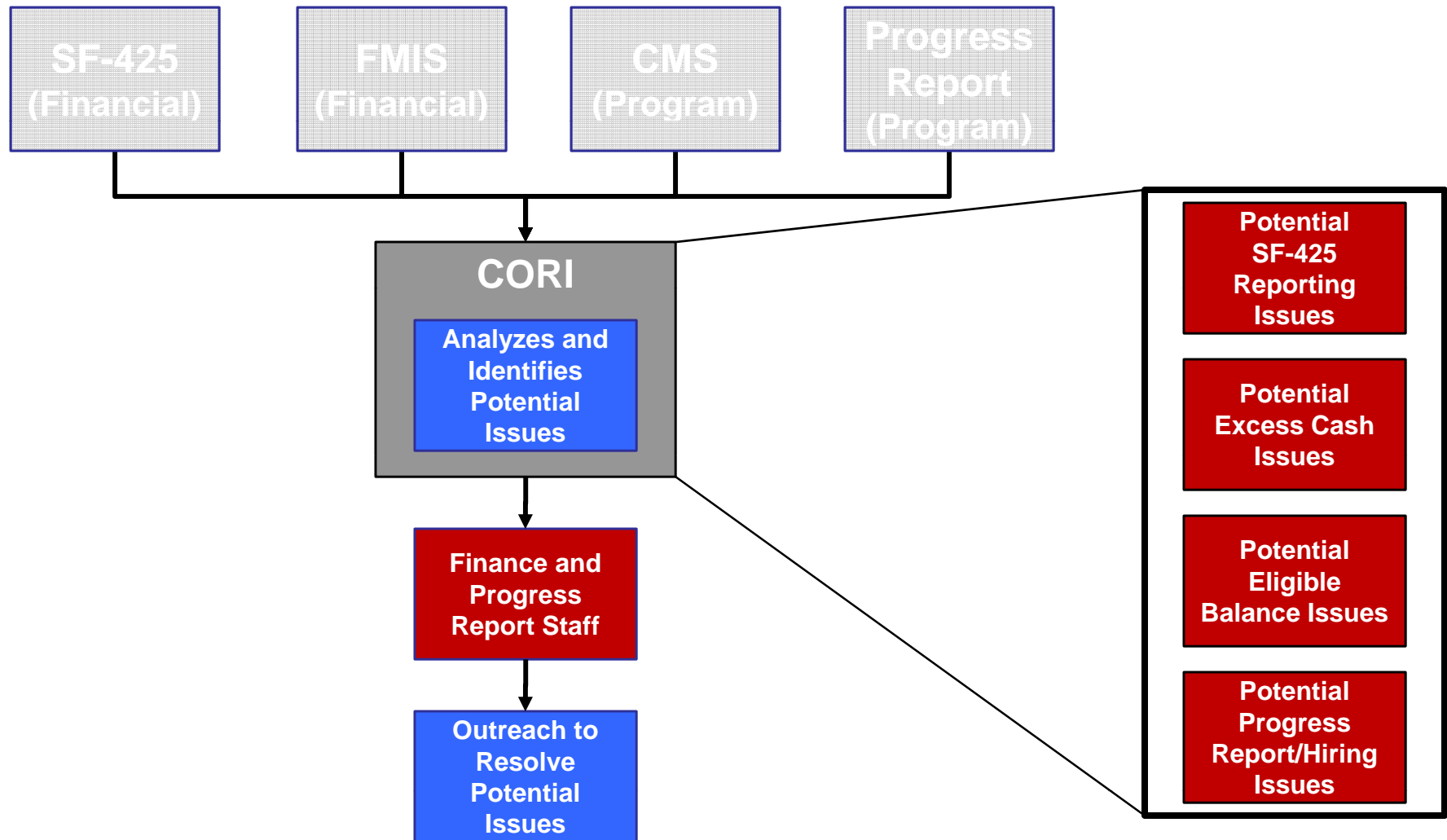
CORI utilizes actual information to predict and project a grantee's expected expenditures.

- Aligns financial and programmatic reporting functions.
- Identifies inconsistencies for research and outreach.
- Standardizes the outreach provided to the grantee.
- Provides additional information to enhance outlay projections.
