VIOLATIONS:
On or around December 12, 2011, the proponent allegedly violated (1) Section 203(b)(1) of Title 27, United States Code, and Section 1.21(a) of Title 27, Code of Federal Regulations, by producing 2,000 gallons of wine without first obtaining the required Federal Basic Permit.
