

**ARRA Snapshot for Federal Lands Highway Program
(Public Law 111-5) - Economic Recovery Act
As of 10/31/12**

- Appropriated from General Fund
- Federal share up to 100% of cost
- Not subject to obligation limitation
- Available for obligation until 09/30/2010
- 4% (\$12.4 million) may be used by DOI for management and oversight of Indian Reservation Road funds

Distribution:

- The Indian Reservation Roads (IRR) funds will be administered by a statutory formula ([25 CFR 170](#)) to 562 federally recognized tribes.
- Forest Highway funds will be administered according to the established statutory formula.
- Park Road and Refuge Road funds will be administered according to regional formulas established by the National Park Service and Fish & Wildlife Service, respectively. They have the flexibility to adjust, as needed to ensure that all funds get obligated.
- Indian Reservation Road and Forest Highway funds not obligated by February 17, 2010, (one year after enactment) may be redistributed within the respective program to ensure all funds get obligated.

Administration:

- Administer programs according to 23 USC 204 procedures
- Projects must be on approved Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and/or on the IRR Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
- Federal Lands Division Offices to deliver/obligate a substantial portion of the ARRA funds on behalf of our partners:
 - Indian Reservation Road: **0%**
 - Park Roads and Parkways: **90%**
 - Forest Highway: **88%**
 - Refuge Road: **100%**
- Requirements for Lake Tahoe regional planning funds authorized in SAFETEA-LU do not apply
- Priority shall be given to projects that:
 - Are projected for completion **by February 17, 2011**
 - Are located in economically distressed areas
- Disadvantaged Business Enterprises rules apply
