- **Name:** Command, Control, Communications, Computers, Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (C4ISR) Center of Excellence.
- **Location:** The C4ISR Center of Excellence is located at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland.
- **C4ISR Materiel Enterprise:** The Army C4ISR Materiel Enterprise is comprised of primarily six independent and inter-dependent organizations that are collectively responsible for the life cycle of C4ISR systems. The team originates from a partnership between the U.S. Army Materiel Command (AMC) and the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Acquisition, Logistics and Technology (ASA/ALT). These team members comprise the C4ISR portion of the Army's Materiel Enterprise, one of four Army Enterprises to include Human Capital; Readiness; and Services and Infrastructure. It's this partnership and collaboration which enables life cycle support for C4ISR systems. Together, these organizations develop, acquire, provide, field and sustain world-class C4ISR systems and battle command capabilities for the joint warfighter. Army Team C4ISR has presence in 31 states and 27 countries.

- **Phase 1 Campus:** Ground broke March 17, 2008 on this \$477 million complex at Aberdeen Proving Ground. Includes 9 new buildings totaling 1.5 million square feet and will accommodate approximately 5000 personnel.
 - Contractor: Tompkins-Turner, Grunley & Kinsley, a Joint Venture.
 - Phase I includes: 5 administrative and laboratory buildings, a secure shop and warehouse, an auditorium and training facility. Totaling 1.5 million square feet.

- **Phase II Campus:** First contract was awarded April 2009. Other major facility contracts awarded August-September 2009. Projected Move in Date is March 2011. Combination of new construction and reuse of ~1M SF of facility total \$325 million. Ground breaking / kick-off ceremony held September 2009.
