Dear Mr. Wright:

We have reviewed the proposed changes to the Illinois regulations, 32III. Adm. Codes: Part 310 "General Provisions for Radiation Protection"; Part 330, "Licensing of Radioactive Material"; Part 335, "Use of Radionuclides in the Healing Arts; Part 340, "Standard for Protection Against Radiation"; Part 346, "Licensed and Radiation Safety Requirements for Irradiatiors"; Part 351, "Radiation Safety Requirements for Wireless Service Operations and Subsurface Tracer Studies"; received by our office on May 2, 2005. These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules in 10 CFR Parts 20, 30, 32, 35, 36, 39, 40 and the requirements of the eight amendments identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the regulations with Ted Henry on June 1, 2005.

As a result of our review, we have no comments on the eight amendments identified in the SRS Sheet. Our review of the remaining amendments identified in the May 2, 2005 letter will be provided in future correspondence, as discussed during a conversation with Mr. Gibb Vincent on June 30, 2005. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. Under our current procedure, a finding that the Illinois regulations meet the compatibility and health and safety categories of the equivalent NRC regulation may only be made based on a review of the final Illinois regulations. However, we have determined that if your proposed regulations were adopted, without significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP) Procedure SA-200.

We request that when the proposed regulations are adopted and published as final regulations, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in STP Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight any final changes and provide a copy to STP. The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of the status of other Illinois regulations, as indicated. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies, or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet.
