Dear Mr. Crawford:

We have reviewed the proposed changes to the Kentucky regulations 902 KAR Chapter 100, received by our office on January 16, 2008. These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules in 10 CFR Parts 20, 30, 32, 34, 35, 36, 39, 40, 61, 70, 71 and the requirements of the 12 amendments identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the regulations with Matthew McKinley on February 19, 2008.

As a result of our review, we have 17 comments that have been identified in the enclosure. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. Under our current procedure, a finding that the Kentucky regulations meet the compatibility and health and safety categories of the equivalent NRC regulation may only be made based on a review of the final Kentucky regulations. However, we have determined that if your proposed regulations were adopted, incorporating our comments and without other significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME) Procedure SA-200.

We request that when the proposed regulations are adopted and published as final regulations, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in FSME Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight the final changes, and provide a copy to Division of Materials Safety and State Agreements, FSME. The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of the status of other Kentucky regulations, as indicated. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies, or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet.
