We have reviewed the proposed revision to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's, Radiation Protection Programs' Rules (N.J.A.C. 7:28-1 et seq.), received by our office on February 27, 2008. These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules in 10 CFR Parts 19, 20, 30, 31, 32, 34, 35, 36, 39, 40, 61, 70, 71, and 150. We discussed our review of the regulations with Jenny Goodman on March 27, 2008.

As a result of our review, we have eight comments that have been identified in the enclosure. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. Under our current procedure, a finding that the New Jersey regulations meet the compatibility and health and safety categories of the equivalent NRC regulation may only be made based on a review of the final New Jersey regulations. However, we have determined that if your proposed regulations were adopted, incorporating our comments and without other significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME) Procedure SA-200. We request that when the proposed regulations are adopted and published as final regulations, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in FSME Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight the final changes, and provide a copy to Division of Materials Safety and State Agreements, FSME.
