We have reviewed the final revisions to the New Mexico regulations, New Mexico Radiation Protection (20.3 NMAC) Parts 3, 4, 12, 15, received by our office on July 20, 2005. These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules in 10 CFR Parts 20, 30, 31, 32, 36, 39, and 150 and the requirements of the six amendments identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the regulations with Stanley Fitch on August 23, 2005.

As a result of our review, we have no comments. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. We have determined that the regulations, as adopted, meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP) Procedure SA-200.

The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of the status of other New Mexico regulations, as indicated.
