

Entity List Clarification: the University of Electronic Science and Technology of China and the 901 Institute

Upon review, BIS has determined that there was a formatting error in an Entity List rule published on December 17, 2010 (75 FR 78883) (the “December 17 rule”). The December 17 rule was intended to have shown the University of Electronic Science and Technology of China (UESTC) and the 901 Institute as separate aliases for the China Academy of Engineering Physics (CAEP), not to show the 901 Institute as part of the UESTC entry. BIS apologizes for any inconvenience resulting from this error and will publish a correction in the *Federal Register* as soon as possible.

Please note that because UESTC and the 901 Institute are considered to be aliases of CAEP, they remain on the Entity List and the Entity List-specific licensing requirements and policy applicable to CAEP apply to UESTC and the Institute. Therefore, a license is required to export, reexport or transfer (in-country) any item subject to the EAR to UESTC or the 901 Institute; BIS will review license applications for items destined to UESTC and the 901 Institute on a case-by-case basis.
