The ICE system enables DoD service providers to collect feedback from their customers so that those services can be improved. Customers submitting feedback via ICE about the services that they have utilized can provide their contact information (name and/or e-mail address and/or telephone number) so that manager of the involved service provider can respond to the customer's feedback. This information is completely voluntary and not providing this information has no impact on submitting a comment.

This automated information system also contains office related user information (e.g. office phone numbers, office e-mail address, title) for ICE manager/user account setup and administration.

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

The privacy risks associated with the PII collected are the unauthorized release of PII data. These risks are addressed by protecting the data collection resource with strong SSL encryption, programmatically restricting the system from releasing PII data through its interfaces. Access to contact information is restricted by user role.
