




# Stone Fruit: World Markets and Trade

## Peach/Nectarine and Cherry: 2012/13 Forecast

### Peach/Nectarine Production and Trade Expanding

**World** production of peaches/nectarines is forecast to continue its decade-long climb in 2012/13, rising 3 percent from the previous year to a record 19.4 million (metric) tons. China accounts for nearly all that expansion. Trade is also up, with global exports forecast to reach a record of more than 660,000 tons.

**U.S.** production is forecast down 5 percent to 1.1 million tons. South Carolina's crop was damaged by hailstorms, while Michigan's crop is substantially reduced following freezing temperatures in the spring. Imports are projected down slightly on weaker demand. Exports are forecast to remain flat at 100,000 tons as top markets remain relatively unchanged.



**China's** production, representing more than half of the world's total, is forecast to reach a record 12.0 million tons on favorable weather as area is up only slightly. Rising demand from Vietnam and Russia is projected to drive exports up nearly 30 percent to 50,000 tons, although storage and transportation challenges continue to limit export potential.

**EU-27** production is forecast to remain steady at 4.3 million tons. Good harvests in Italy, Spain, and Greece are forecast to offset falling production in other Member States. Spain's production is growing with new, higher yielding varieties, as well as expanded planted area. Exports are forecast up at 325,000 tons on rising demand from Ukraine. Imports are projected to remain at 30,000 tons, with most off-season demand met by Chile and South Africa.

**Turkey's** production is up slightly to 550,000 tons on favorable weather conditions. Exports are projected to jump by more than 35 percent to 45,000 tons, based on rising demand from Ukraine and Russia and larger supplies.

**Chile's** production is projected to remain virtually unchanged at approximately 150,000 tons. Planted area has been trending down for several years as farmers have updated their orchards with higher-yielding varieties. Exports remain nearly unchanged from the previous year at 94,000 tons.

**Taiwan's** production is forecast virtually unchanged, while imports are projected to decline slightly to 20,000 tons. The United States continues to be the dominant supplier in Taiwan, accounting for four fifths of imported peaches/nectarines.

### Global Cherry Production Down, but Trade Growing


**World** cherry production is virtually unchanged for the third year in a row at 2.4 million tons in 2012/13. Consumption of fresh cherries is forecast up slightly, while the quantity of cherries for processing is forecast down 10 percent from the previous year. Trade is forecast to expand, with world exports reaching a record of nearly 300,000 tons on rising demand from Asian countries, particularly China.

**U.S.** production is projected down to approximately 375,000 tons as sharply lower tart cherry production more than offsets growth in sweet cherries. Tart cherry production, which serves the processing market almost exclusively, is forecast nearly 70 percent smaller as a result of freezing temperatures during budding in Michigan. Sweet cherry production, which accounts for virtually all exports, is forecast up nearly 15

percent to 340,000 tons based on favorable weather on the West Coast. The larger sweet cherry production is boosting exportable supplies and reducing import demand. Exports are forecast to surge by more than 25 percent to 90,000 tons, with shipments to South Korea expected to more than double, spurred by the trade agreement signed this year.

**EU-27** production is forecast slightly down to about 780,000 tons, as a result of reduced plantings in some Member States and unfavorable weather during vulnerable growth stages. Import demand remains steady, as the falling production has mainly affected domestic consumption and the processing market. As a net importer of cherries, Turkey is its largest supplier.

**Turkey's** production is forecast to rebound 25 percent from last year, reaching 500,000 tons, but falling short of the record set in 2010/11. The harvest was supported by favorable weather during blooming and the absence of frost damage in most growing areas. Larger exportable supplies, combined with rising demand from Russia and the EU-27 are forecast to drive Turkey's exports up almost 30 percent to 60,000 tons.

**China's** production is forecast down nearly 20 percent to 170,000 tons following heavy rains during flowering in Shandong, the major producing province. Consequently, imports are forecast up 70 percent to 40,000 tons, partly filling this shortfall. Imported U.S. cherries are more price competitive as a result of the significant rise in domestic prices from the smaller harvest. Imports from Chile have nearly doubled from the previous year. China has become a major import market as consumers prefer imported cherries for their sweeter taste and firmer skin.

**Chile's** production is forecast up slightly to 92,000 tons as area continues to expand. Exports are projected to rise to 76,000 tons with larger shipments anticipated to EU-27, Japan, and China.

**Japan's** production is projected to ease from last year's bumper crop, settling at 20,000 tons. Farmers are cultivating varieties with different peak harvest times to produce more efficiently. Imports, sourced almost exclusively from the United States, are projected to remain steady at 10,000 tons.

**Taiwan's** imports are forecast up nearly 25 percent to 15,000 tons. The United States continues to supply more than half of the cherry market in Taiwan, although its market share has diminished somewhat as Chile now supplies the market during the U.S. offseason.

## Updates to 2011/12

- Peach/Nectarine production in Australia is revised up 33,000 tons to 128,000.
- Peach/Nectarine exports for EU-27 are revised up 15,000 tons to 315,000 based on higher-than-expected demand from Russia.
- Cherry exports for Chile are revised up 8,000 tons to 70,000 driven by larger-than-anticipated shipments to China.
- Cherry production in EU-27 is revised up 184,000 tons to 834,000 due to adjusted area data.
- Cherry imports in EU-27 are revised up 15,000 tons to 40,000 driven by higher-than-anticipated demand, both in the fresh and the processing markets.

Trade and production data back to 2001/02 were added or revised for several countries in the database. For peaches/nectarines, the following countries were added: Argentina, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Ukraine, and Uzbekistan. For cherries, the following countries were added: Hong Kong, Kyrgyzstan, South Korea, Syria, Ukraine, and Uzbekistan.
