Communion Rite

Priest: The peace of the Lord be with you always.

People: **And with your spirit.**

Priest: **Behold** the Lamb of God, **behold him** who takes away the sins of the world.

Blessed are those **called to the supper of the Lamb.**

All: Lord, I am not worthy **that you should enter under my roof**, but only say the
word and **my soul** shall be healed.

Concluding Rite

Priest: The Lord be with you.
