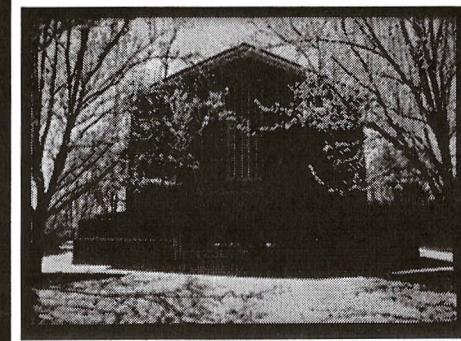

Theological T.F.T.W. (Rev. C.H. Spurgeon, "A Baptismal Sermon," London, 1881): "We declare in baptism that we believe in the death of Jesus, and desire to partake in all the merit of it. But there is a second equally important matter and that is *our realized union with Christ* which is set forth in baptism, not so much as a doctrine of our creed as a matter of our experience.
