MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Bavaria Military Community Policy Letter #9; USAG Grafenwoehr Standards of Conduct, Dress and Appearance

1. **Effective Date.** This policy letter remains in effect until superseded or rescinded.
2. **Scope and Punitive Effect.** This policy letter applies to all service members, DOD civilians, and Family Members. Failure to comply with the provisions of this policy letter may result in adverse administrative or punitive action to include the Uniform Code of Military Justice for service members, and civilian misconduct proceedings for other affiliated personnel.
3. **Reference.**
 - a. AR 670-1, Wear and Appearance of Army Uniforms and Insignia, 5 September 2005 (and sister service equivalent regulations).
 - b. AER 525-13, Force Protection.
4. **Policy.** Service regulations govern military appearance and safety. USAG Grafenwoehr relies on self-discipline, leadership and the units' chain of command to enforce these regulations. This policy only clarifies areas not specifically covered in the regulations. It is possible for unit commanders to pass a more stringent policy among its members.
 - a. Headphones may be worn with service physical fitness uniforms while in the gym. This allows patrons to use the video support and enhance personal fitness.
 - b. A clean Army Physical Fitness Uniform (APFU) may be worn in on-base community facilities.
 - c. Wet or sweaty APFUs or Army Combat Uniforms (ACUs) will not be worn in these facilities.
 - d. Civilian attire will not display language of an offensive or sexual nature.
 - e. Do not use foul language in public areas.
 - f. Wear of military uniforms off the installation will be IAW current Force Protection requirements.
